



Measuring Distances





Throwing Boomerangs

Description

Children to throw an object linked to their topic i.e. a boomerang for an Australia topic. The children will then measure the distance they have thrown the Object using a trundle wheel and record the distance.

Curriculum links

use non-standard units to measure: – length, height and distance– MD Year 1 Practise a variety of ways of sending - PD

Equipment

Sequencing cards, beanbags, balls



Teaching Points

Encourage children to step in with opposite step forward.

Use spots to promote this.

Children could a tie scarf or place a sticker on the opposite foot for support.

Get the children to discuss different forms of travelling.

Encourage the children to use their loco motor skills efficiently.
