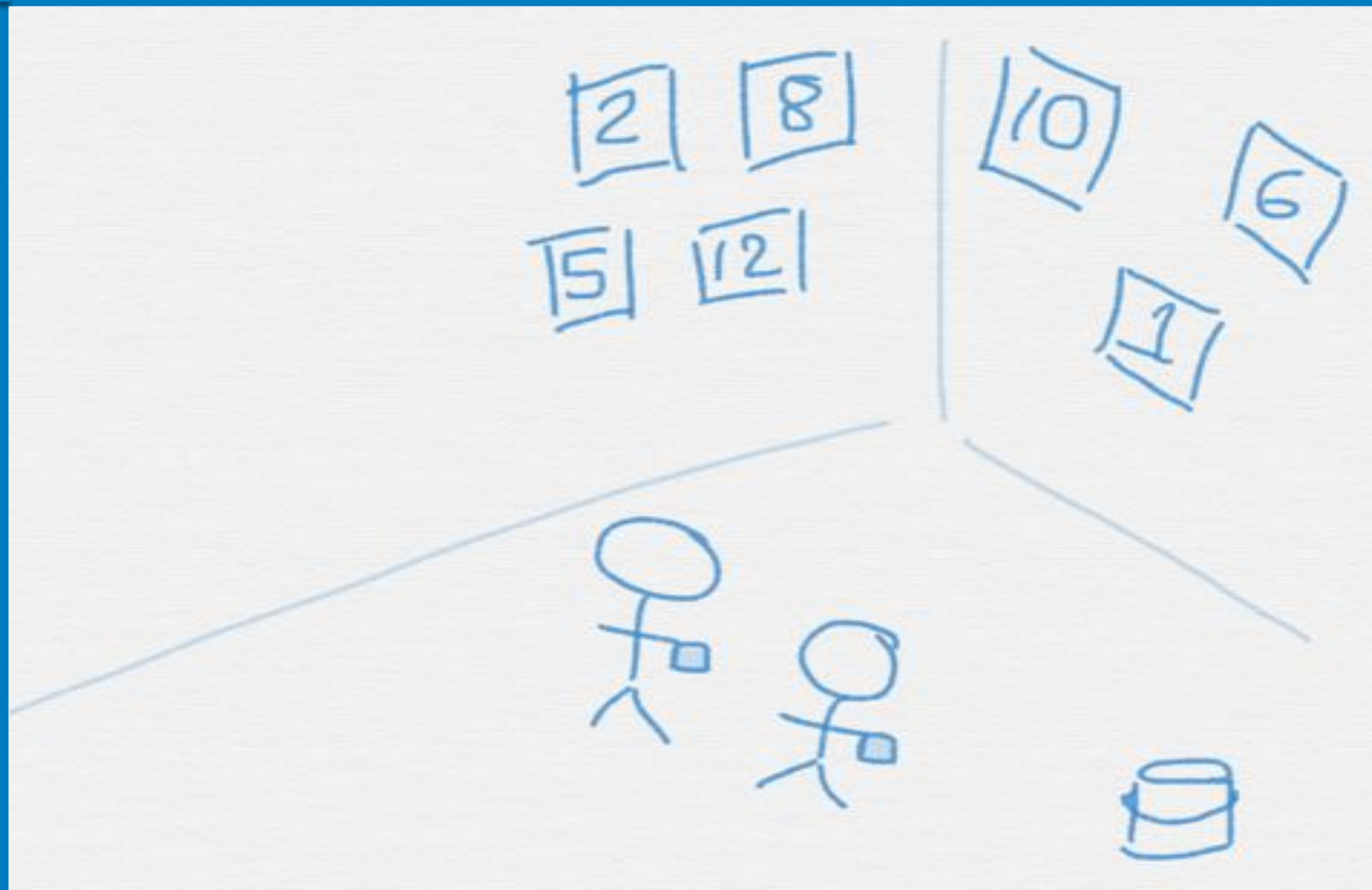




Number bonds to 10



Overarm throw at the answer

Description

Search a number sentence from a pile or a bucket. Use a number line or mental maths skills to complete the number sentence. Once the children have worked out the answer collect a bean bag and overarm throw the beanbag at the answer stuck or chalked on the wall.

Teaching Points

Encourage children to step in with opposite step forward. Use spots to promote this. Children could a tie scarf or place a sticker on the opposite foot for support. Another child could stand behind the child with a beanbag on a bat to encourage the child to reach back and start the movement from behind.
