



# Time



What's the time?  
Throw the beanbag

## Description

Place 12 hula hoops on the ground to make a clock face and a spot in the centre. Show the children a time on a small clock, o'clock or half past. Children to record the numbers in the hoops and tell the time using the beanbags. For example, 4 o'clock, throw the beanbag into the 12 for the big hand and then the 4 for the small hand. Children could also travel to the appropriate number.

## Teaching Points

Encourage children to step in with opposite step forward. Use spots to promote this. Children could tie a scarf or place a sticker on the opposite foot for support. Hopping and jumping appropriately.

## Curriculum links

Use standard units of time to read 'o'clock' using both analogue and 12-hour digital clocks— MD Year 1  
Practise a variety of ways of sending - PD

## Equipment

Hula hoops, chalk, beanbags, spots, scarfs and stickers
